Female Arkansas City pedestrian struck in hit-and-run accident

Police seeking information in connection with Saturday's incident on Summit

ARKANSAS CITY, Kan. (June 15, 2016) — The Arkansas City Police Department is seeking any information in connection with a hit-and-run accident Saturday involving a pedestrian on Summit Street.

Police and the Arkansas City Fire-EMS Department responded just prior to midnight to the 1100 block of North Summit Street for a report of a pedestrian who had been hit by a motor vehicle.

An Arkansas City woman was walking across the street in the 1200 block of North Summit Street when she was struck by a vehicle that was southbound on Summit.

A nearby witness reported hearing the vehicle strike something, but did not see what it was.

The witness also reported seeing the vehicle stop immediately, but then it sped off and left the scene southbound on Summit. The vehicle was described as a dark-colored van of unknown make or model.

The 19-year-old female who was struck by the vehicle was transported to South Central Kansas Medical Center, where she was treated for her injuries.
