Firefighters to Fill the Boot for Muscular Dystrophy Association

Arkansas City Fire-EMS Department participating in annual fundraiser Sept. 4

ARKANSAS CITY, Kan. (September 1, 2017) — The Arkansas City Fire-EMS Department is teaming up with the Muscular Dystrophy Association (MDA) for the annual Fill the Boot Campaign on Labor Day.

Local firefighters will fill their boots with donations from Arkansas City residents from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. Sept. 4 at the intersection of Fifth Avenue and Summit Street in downtown Arkansas City.

The fire-EMS department hopes collecting on Labor Day will increase funds significantly for MDA.

Fill the Boot funds support MDA's services locally and nationally, including medical clinics staffed with specialists in neuromuscular disease and special summer camps for kids stricken by the disease.
